HOW WE DO IT

HouseProud Atlanta secures highly qualified, licensed, and insured contractors to perform approved home repairs. Volunteers assist with low to moderate level repairs under the guidance of contractors and HouseProud staff.

WHY WE DO IT

Rising costs make it difficult, and sometimes impossible, for many seniors to pay for critical or even simple repairs. Through advocacy and education initiatives, HouseProud also works to provide resources and knowledge needed to overcome common homeownership difficulties.

No-cost home repairs for Greater Atlanta's deserving homeowners

Typical repair and maintenance projects:



Weatherstripping and caulking doors or windows, add insulation, repair and replace HVAC units, replace thermostats, ceiling fan replacement, hot water heater replacement, and more.



Electrical repairs, exterior security lights, repair and replace rotten floor joists, repair and replace floor sheathing, replace rotted porch wood, repair or replace steps, replace storm/front/screen doors, add or repair wheelchair ramp, install exterior handrails, replace broken window panes, and more.



Replace and repair roofs, install and repair chimney flashing, replace shingles, repair and replace gutters, paint unprotected wood (per city citation), repair fascia/soffit, clear exterior debris, plumbing repair and replacement, exterior painting, and more.
